## **SESQUICENTENNIAL CALENDAR**

The Sheridan Sesquicentennial Committee is now taking orders for the beautiful keepsake 2010 Sesquicentennial Calendar to be available by November 1<sup>st</sup>. This will be a fully functional one year calendar, with each month featuring a photo collage of a local not-for-profit organization. The calendar will list daily community events and meetings to help keep people organized throughout the year. A separate insert included with the calendar will highlight the special activities surrounding the 10-day period of the sesquicentennial celebration from June 25 to July 4, 2010. As a special bonus, also included in the calendar package will be a coloring book for boys and girls of all ages depicting historic events in Sheridan's past. The calendars are expected to be available by November 1, 2009.

Sheridan community organizations are asked to submit their projected 2010 meeting dates for inclusion on the calendar free of charge. Individual community members are also encouraged to have their own birthdays, anniversaries and other special events commemorated by having them listed in the calendar for \$1.00 each. Submissions should be made to Steve Martin at the Sheridan Public Library, 103 West First Street, Sheridan IN 46069.

Pre-publication orders for the calendar, the insert and coloring book package placed before October 15 are only a \$10 donation. After October 15, the regular donation amount of \$12 will kick in. In addition, each of the 3 items can be ordered separately. Orders must be accompanied with the appropriate donation amount. Orders will be taken at various venues and events around the community for the next several months, and can always be placed at the public library during normal library hours. All donations will be used to offset the expenses of the sesquicentennial celebration being planned.
